

Artworks for Community Groups Guidelines 2017

Artworks available FREE

The City of Karratha is making artworks that are surplus to its needs available **free** to eligible community groups for their fundraising efforts.

Artworks

These artworks have been acquired via a variety of avenues, however have predominantly been purchased by the City of Karratha or donated. They range in sizes and mediums used.

Applicants must specify the artwork/s they desire as a number of artworks are available. Applicants may receive up to 5 pieces of art, subject to assessment of all applications.

The artworks are provided as is and without warranty. Successful applicants will be required to collect the artwork/s from a nominated place at a nominated time.

Conditions

- Any not-for-profit art, sporting or community club or association operating within the City of Karratha may apply for the artworks to assist with fundraising opportunities for that group.
- Individuals are not eligible.
- Applications will be assessed against predetermined criteria, including the overall benefit the fundraising opportunity will provide to the applicant.
- All requested information must be provided in the application.
- Applicants can apply for up to 5 artworks.
- Council will allocate artworks based on those applications that meet the eligibility criteria until all artworks have been allocated.
- Applications open on **30th January 2017** and must be submitted on the City of Karratha's Artworks for Community Groups Application Form, available at www.karratha.wa.gov.au. All applications must be signed by the President and/or Chairperson of the organisation applying.
- All applications **must** be received by **4pm on 3rd March 2017**.
- Applications without the signature of the President and/or Chairperson will not be accepted.
- Incomplete applications will not be processed and will be returned to the applicant.
- All groups will be advised of the outcome of their application before the end of March 2017.
- There is no right of appeal should an applicant not receive an artwork.
- There will be an opportunity to view the artwork at the Dampier Community Hub from 20th to 24th February 2017. Please email dampier.hub@karratha.wa.gov.au to express your interest.
