



Local Government Act 1995

The Council of the City of Karratha resolved on 20 March 2017 that it proposes to make the following local laws:

- Repeal Local Law 2017; and
- Activities in Thoroughfares and Public Places and Trading Local Law 2017.

The purpose and effect of the proposed local laws are as follows:

Repeal Local Law 2017

Purpose:

To repeal the Shire of Roebourne's Beekeeping Local Law, Signs, Hoarding and Bill Posting By-Law, and Tidepole Island Local Law.

Effect:

To remove obsolete and outdated Local Laws relating to the district of the City of Karratha.

Activities in Thoroughfares and Public Places and Trading Local Law 2017

Purpose:

To regulate the care, control and management of activities in thoroughfares, public places and trading.

Effect:

To control the use of local government thoroughfares, public places and trading. Some activities are permitted only under a permit or under a determination and some activities are restricted or prohibited. Offences are created for inappropriate behaviour in or on local government thoroughfares, public places and trading.

A copy of the proposed local laws may be inspected at or obtained from the City of Karratha's Administration Office located at Welcome Road, Karratha between 9.00am and 4.00pm weekdays, and at the Dampier, Wickham and Roebourne Libraries during normal opening hours.
