2 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

INTERPRETATION

In these terms and conditions the following words have the following meanings:

Offer: means the offer to purchase a vehicle submitted on the Offer Form by a prospective Purchaser.

Offer Form: means the attached offer form to be completed by prospective Purchasers.

Purchaser/s: means all prospective purchasers who submit an Offer to purchase a vehicle.

City: means the City of Karratha.

INSPECTION

The vehicles will be available for inspection at the City Depot on Saturday 16th June 2018 between 10:00am and 11:00am **by appointment only**. No alternative inspection times will be available.

Appropriate, fully enclosed footwear must be worn when inspecting vehicles. The City reserves the right to refuse entry to the holding area if footwear is not considered suitable.

PURCHASER TO RELY ON OWN ENQUIRIES

By submitting their Offer, the Purchaser warrants and

represents that it has made its own enquiries and investigations and all other relevant information so as to inform itself of all risks and contingencies which may affect its offer price. The Purchaser shall be deemed to have made their Offer having made a physical inspection of the vehicle.

Purchasers are to satisfy themselves prior to lodging an Offer as to the condition of the vehicle and shall exercise and rely on their own judgement as to the description and condition of the vehicle.

It is the responsibility of the Purchaser to fully investigate so as to satisfy themselves that there is no encumbrance on the vehicle they wish to purchase.

“AS IS/WHERE IS” CONDITION

The abandoned vehicles for sale are offered on the basis of their “as is” condition and “where lying” location. The City accepts no liability for the condition of any vehicle offered or any changes to the condition of any vehicle following inspection.

Any items in the vehicles/s become the property and responsibility of the Purchaser. Dumping of these items on City property is prohibited.

RIGHT TO WITHDRAW

The City reserves the right to withdraw any vehicle from the sale at any time during the process.

RESERVE PRICE

The offer price for each vehicle must be greater than \$150.00. Offers may be submitted for individual vehicles or any number thereof. Offers received below the reserve price will be rejected.

All Offers must remain valid for a period of 30 days from the deadline, specified below.

DELIVERY METHOD

The Offer Form is to be:

(a) placed in a sealed envelope clearly endorsed with the title “Sale of Abandoned Vehicles” and the Impound Number shown on the attached specifications; and

(b) delivered by hand to the City Administration Building, 1083 Welcome Road, Karratha and placed in the Box marked “Sale of Abandoned Vehicles” or sent

through the mail to the Chief Executive Officer,

**Electronic mail offers and offers submitted by
facsimile *will not* be accepted.**

LODGEMENT OF OFFERS

Offers must be lodged by the deadline which is

2:00PM Friday 22nd June 2018.

REJECTION OF OFFERS

An Offer shall be rejected without consideration of its merits in the event that it is not submitted before the deadline, specified above and at the place specified above and may be rejected if it fails to comply with any other requirements of the Offer Form.

Failure of Purchasers to meet these terms and conditions will automatically negate the acceptance of the Offer.

ACCEPTANCE OF OFFERS

The City is not bound to accept any Offer, but expects to accept the highest Offer. If no Offer is accepted for a vehicle, the City will determine the most cost effective and efficient way to dispose of the vehicle.

Where Offers of identical value are received, lots will be drawn to determine the successful bid.

The City's acceptance of an Offer is final. There is no right of appeal on any matter associated with the Offer.

CANVASSING OF ELECTED MEMBERS & COUNCIL STAFF

If a Purchaser, whether personally or by an agent, canvasses any of the City's elected Members (as the case may be) or staff with a view to influencing the acceptance of any Offer made by it or any other Offer, then regardless of such canvassing having any influence on the acceptance of such Offer, the City may at its discretion omit the Offer from consideration.

PAYMENT

The successful Purchaser shall, within seven (7) working days of the date of the letter, accepting their Offer, make payment in full.

Any vehicle(s) not collected within the period referred to above, may be disposed of by the City as they see fit and any payment the Purchaser has made shall be forfeited. The City will issue a "Tax Invoice" to the successful Purchaser upon receipt of payment for the vehicle.

COLLECTION OF VEHICLE/S

The vehicle is to be collected within seven (7) working days of the date of the letter, accepting the Purchaser's Offer.

The vehicle(s) is to be collected from the City's Depot, Cowle Road, Karratha WA between 7:00am and 4:30pm Monday to Friday. An appointment to collect is to be arranged by contacting Darrell Hutchens on (08) 9186 8555. A registered Tow Truck Contractor is to be engaged for the collection of the vehicle. **No car trailers will be permitted on site.**

Any vehicle(s) not collected within the period referred to above, may be disposed of by the City as they see fit and any payment the Purchaser has made shall be forfeited.
