## Our survey approach

The Annual Community Survey gathers feedback from the community on how we have performed over the past 12 months and what our priorities should be in the future

- 1430 completed responses, similar to last year's uptake (1507) although slow start
- Primary source of dissemination was via the City of Karratha Facebook page
- Specific demographics were targeted via promoted Facebook posts and Messenger ads with good results
- Hardcopy surveys went to:
  - City of Karratha Administration Office Reception
  - Community Engagement Team
- 99.99% of respondents completed the survey online

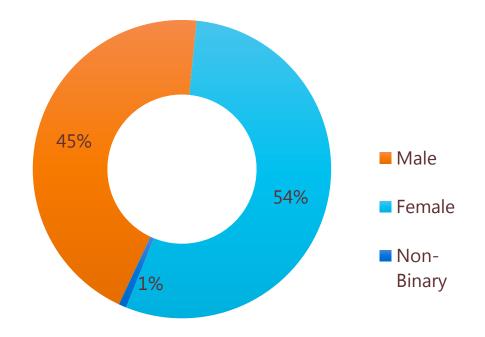

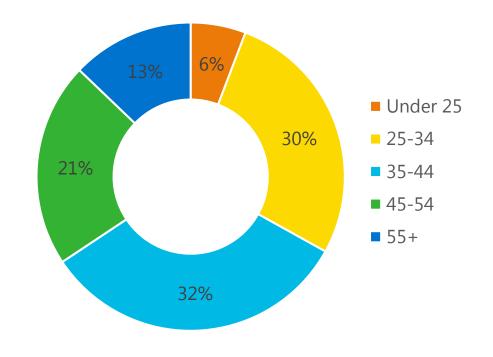

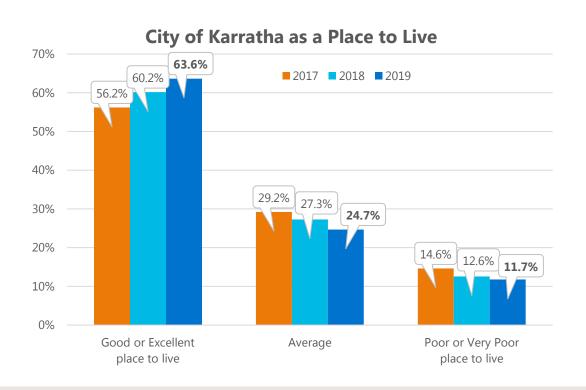

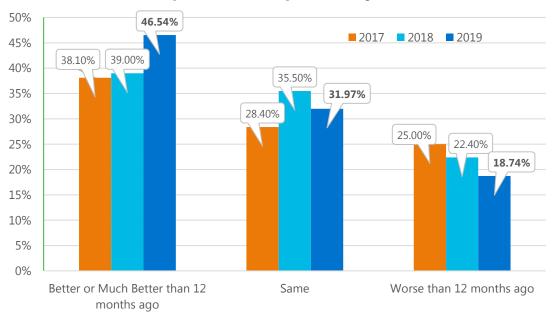
## **Opinions about the City**



- 63.62% of people surveyed think the City of Karratha is a good or excellent place to live better than last year
- 11.74% of people think it is poor or very poor (down from 2018)
- Overall, 88.27% think the City is an average or better place to live, an improvement on previous years

## **Opinions about the City**

### Compared to the past two years...



- 46.54% believe the City is a better or much better place to live than 12 months ago (7.5% increase)
- **18.74%** believe it is worse (down 3.6% on last year)
- Overall, 78.5% think we're either the same of better than last year, up from 74.5% last year

## The best and worst of the City

### The best things about living in the City are the same as last year:

- 1. Natural environment **76/100**
- 2. Leisure, recreation and entertainment **72.2/100**
- 3. Sense of Community **68.4/100**



- 1. Cost of living **44.4/100**
- 2. Safety and security **48.2/100**
- 3. Retail offerings **52.2/100**

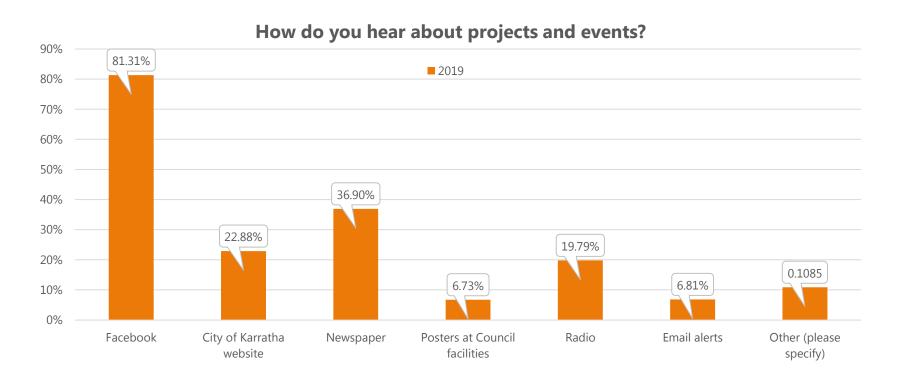




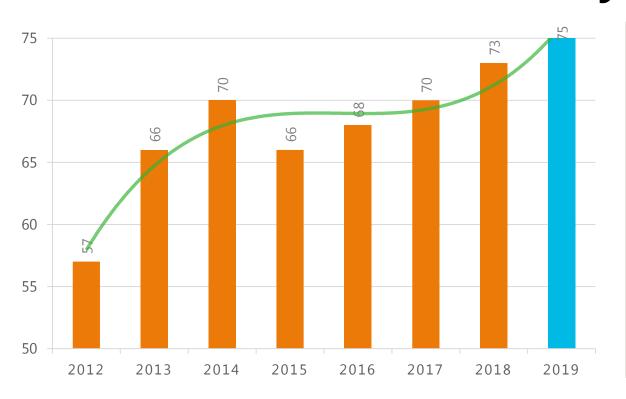

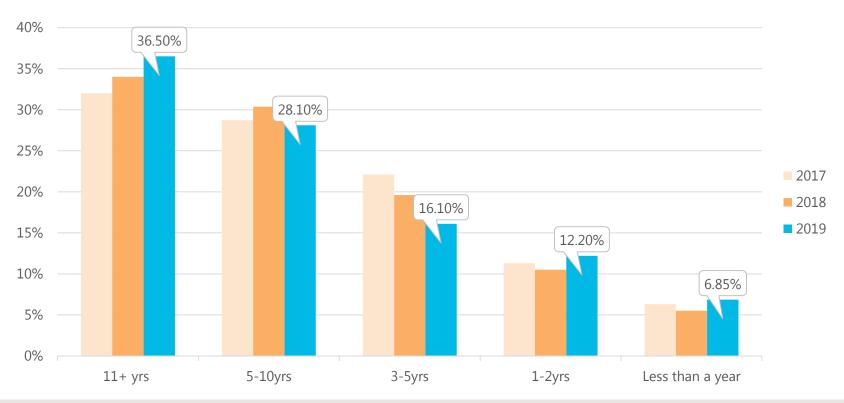

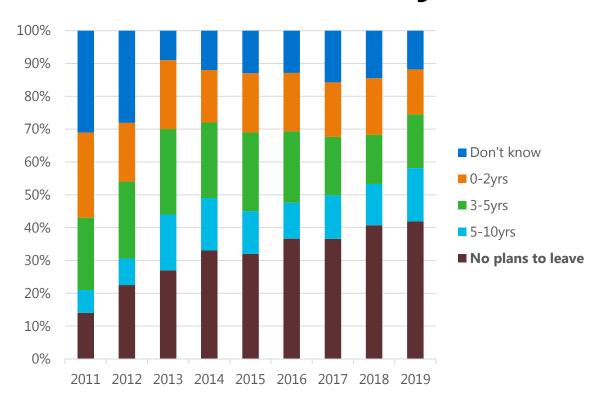

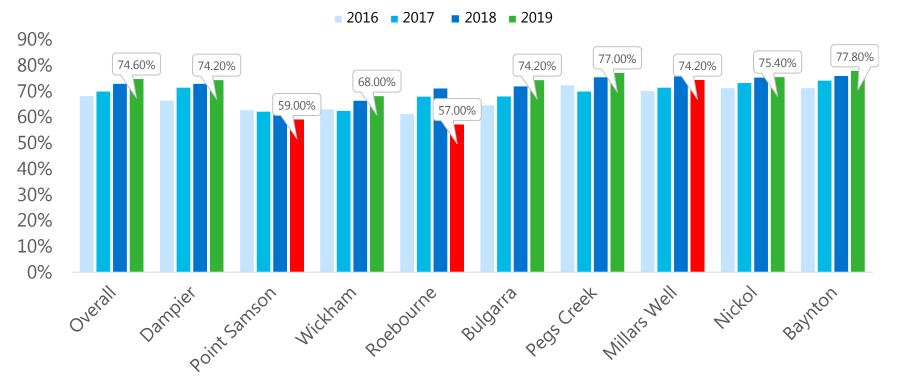

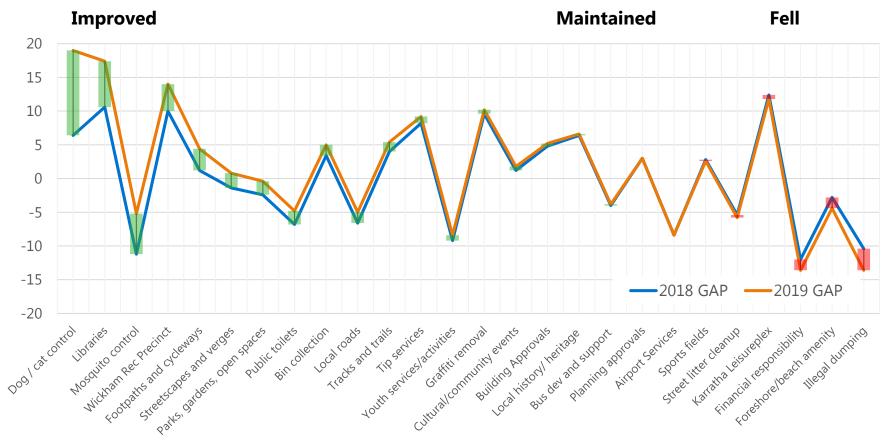

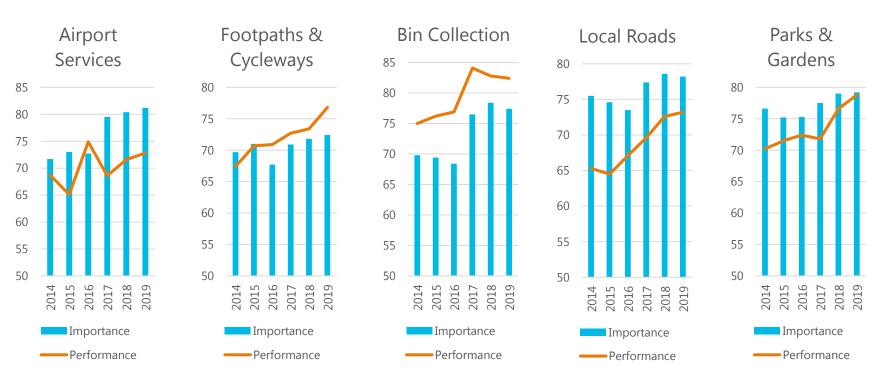
## Gap trend 2019 v 2018



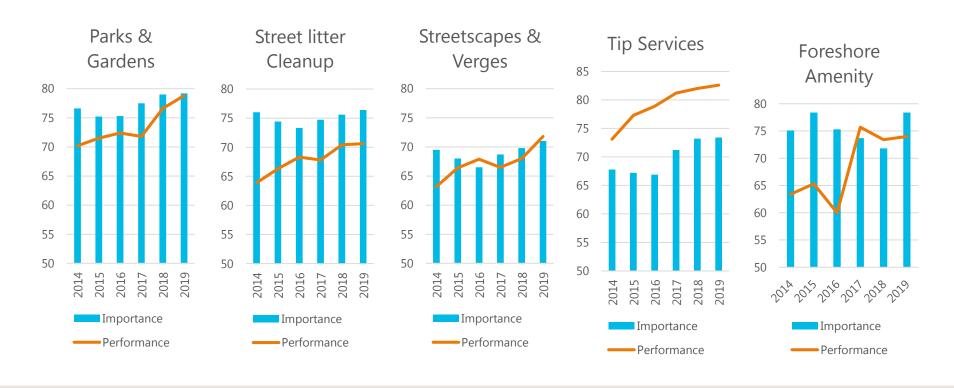
## Change in service gaps: 2019 v 2018



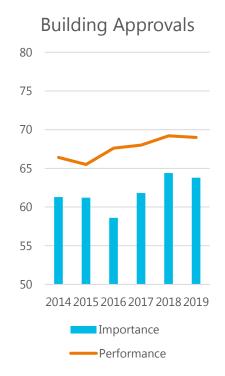
