

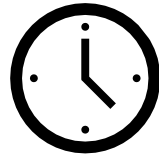
2024 Annual Community Survey Results

Our survey approach

The Annual Community Survey gathers feedback from the community on how we have performed over the past 12 months and what our priorities should be in the future.



2075 completed responses up from 909 in 2023



9 February – 8 March open for **4 weeks**



2062 surveys completed online
13 paper-based

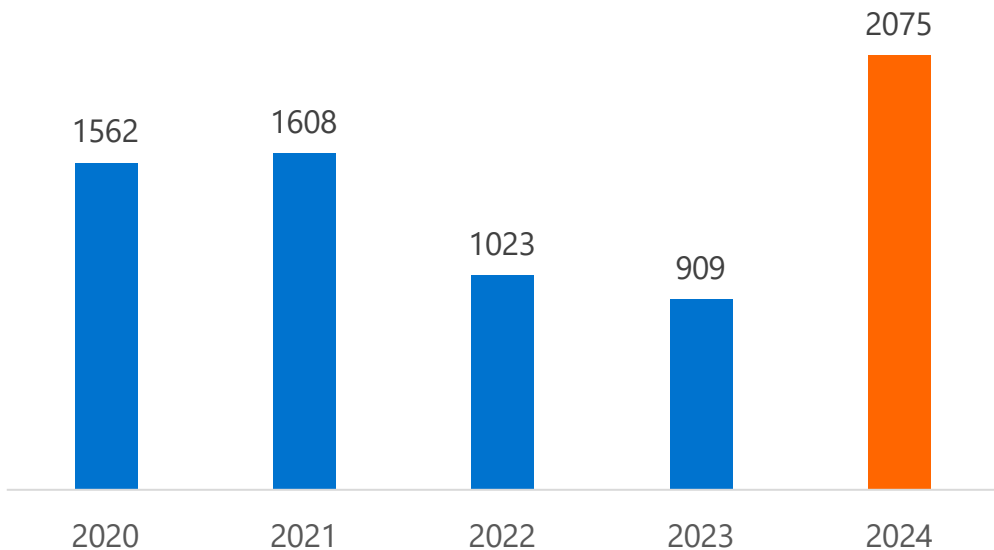


Promoted online, on radio and with local community groups. This encouraged participation from different demographic groups.

Participation



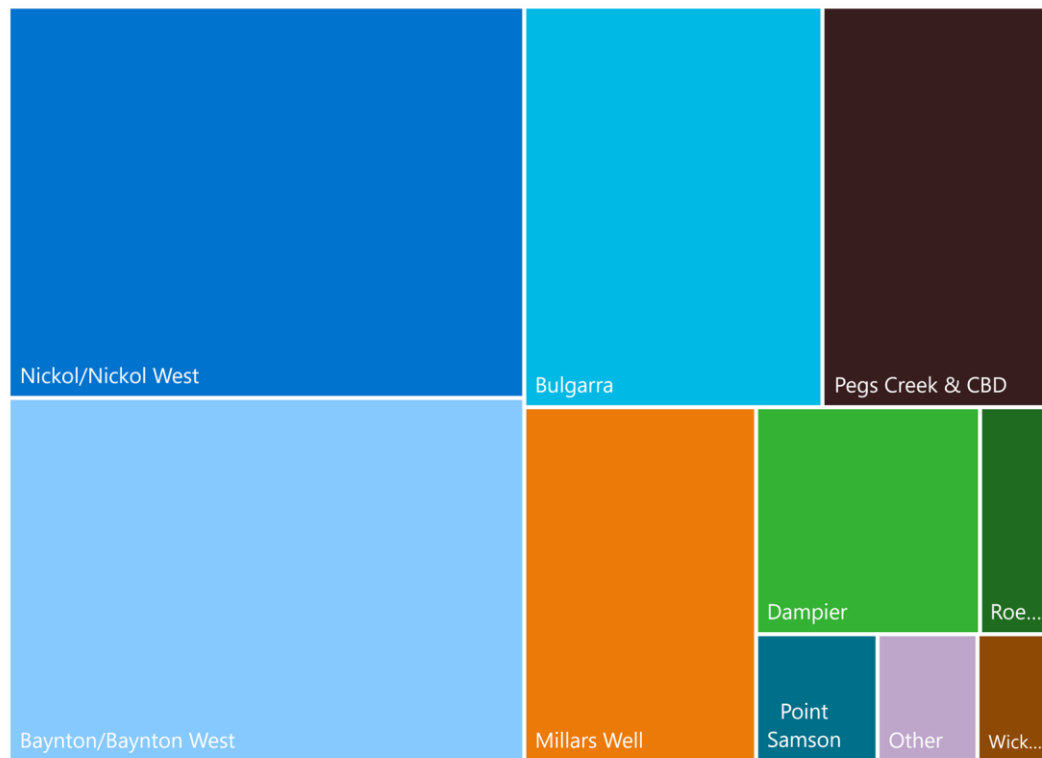
Up 128%



- Participation rates increased by 228% from 2023 – exceeding the four-year average of 67%.
- Increased participation provides a higher level of confidence of statistical results.

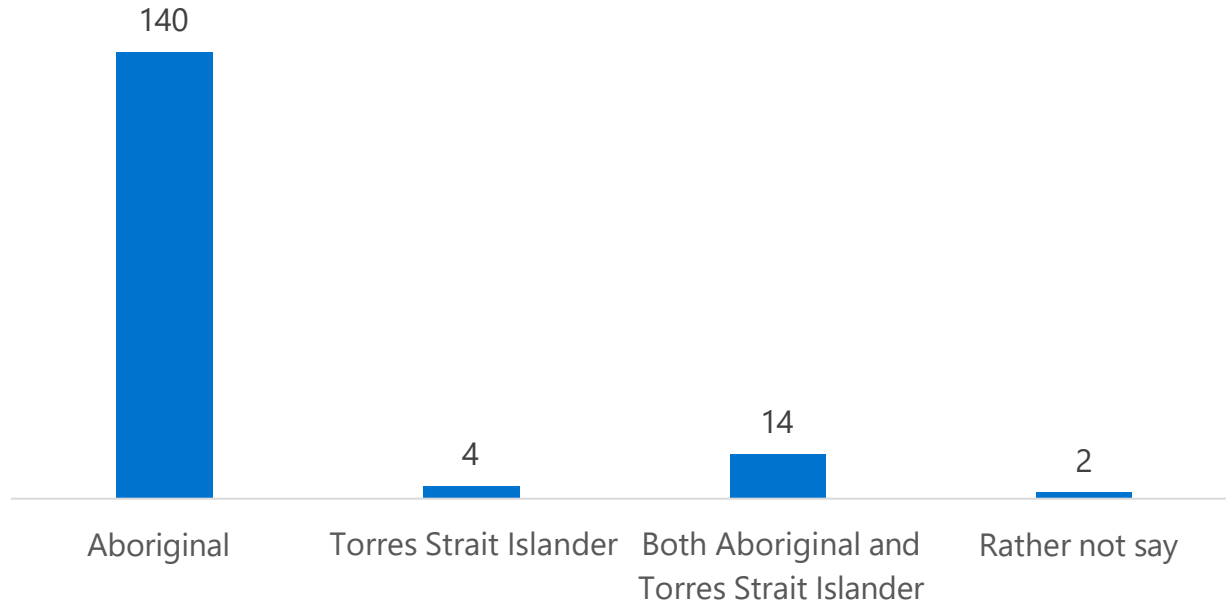

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Representation



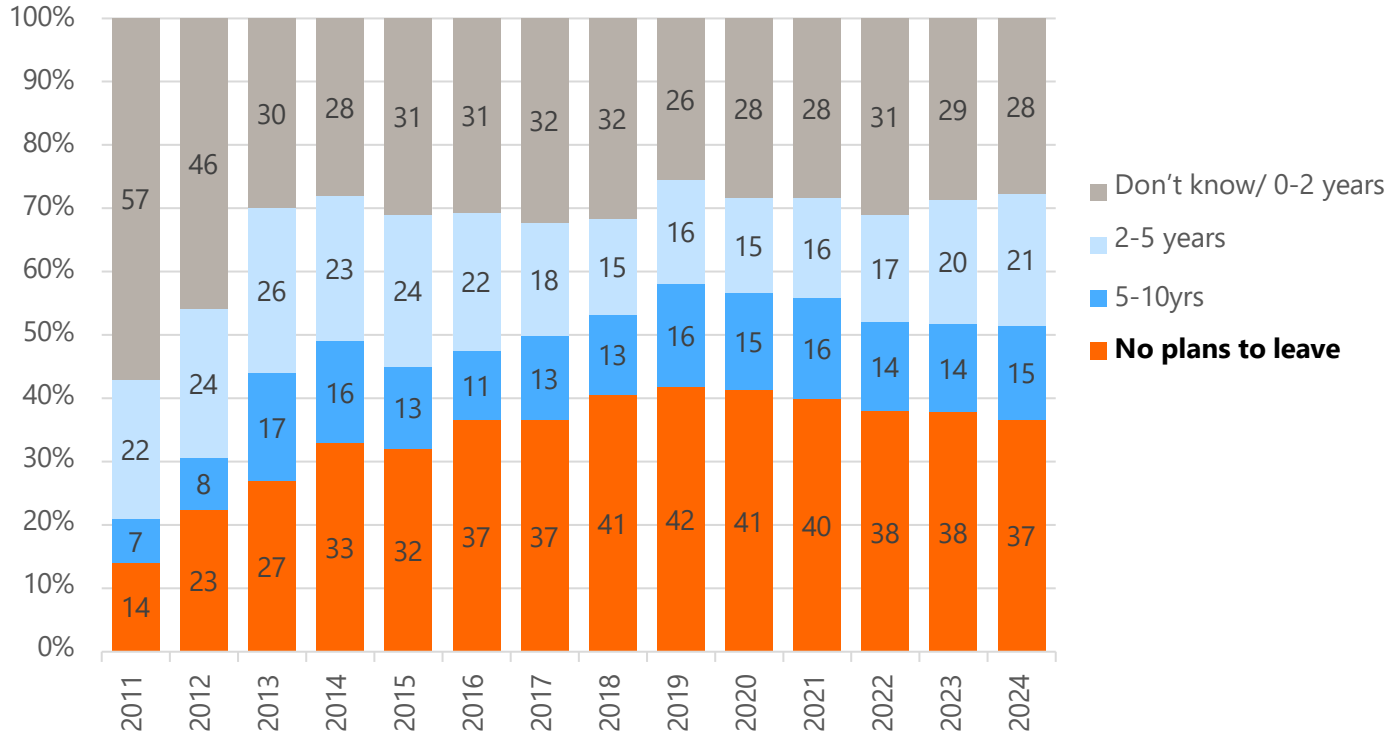
- For the first time in 2024, we asked respondents if they were Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.

How long have you lived in the city



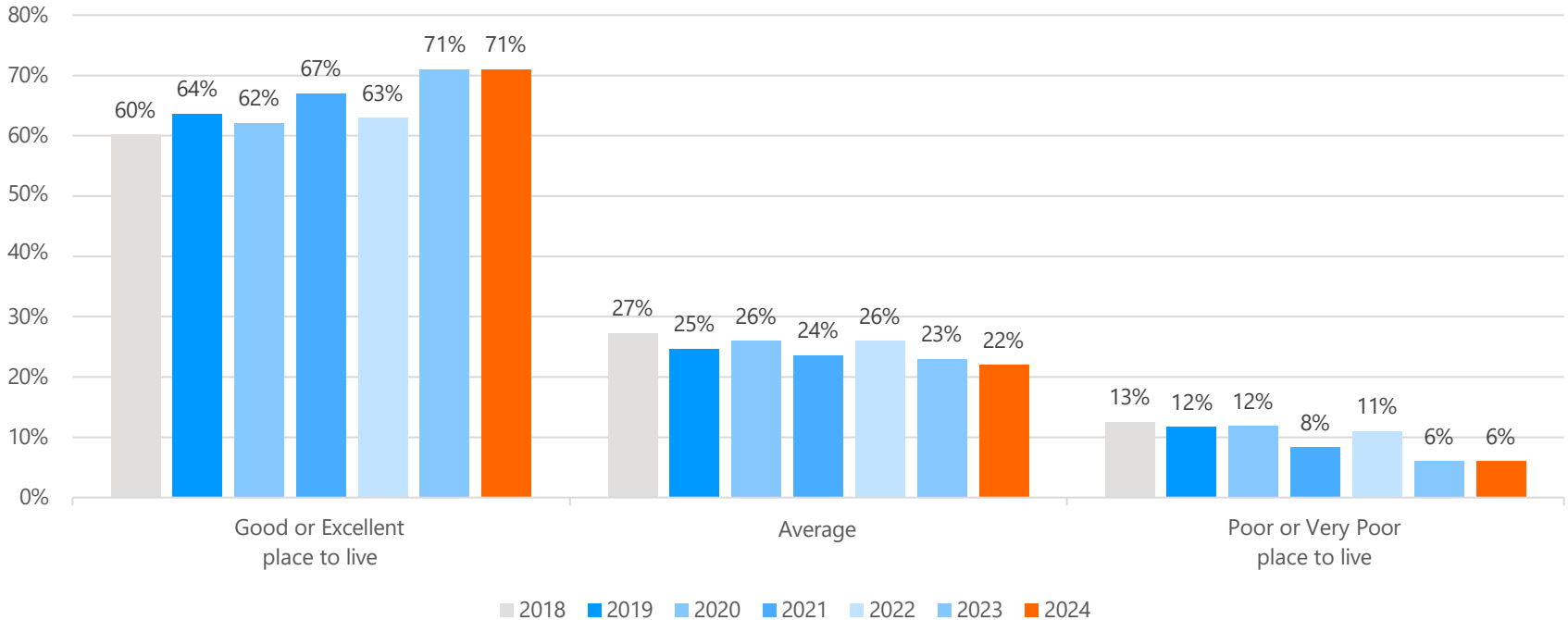

Slight decrease in number of people with 'no plans to leave'

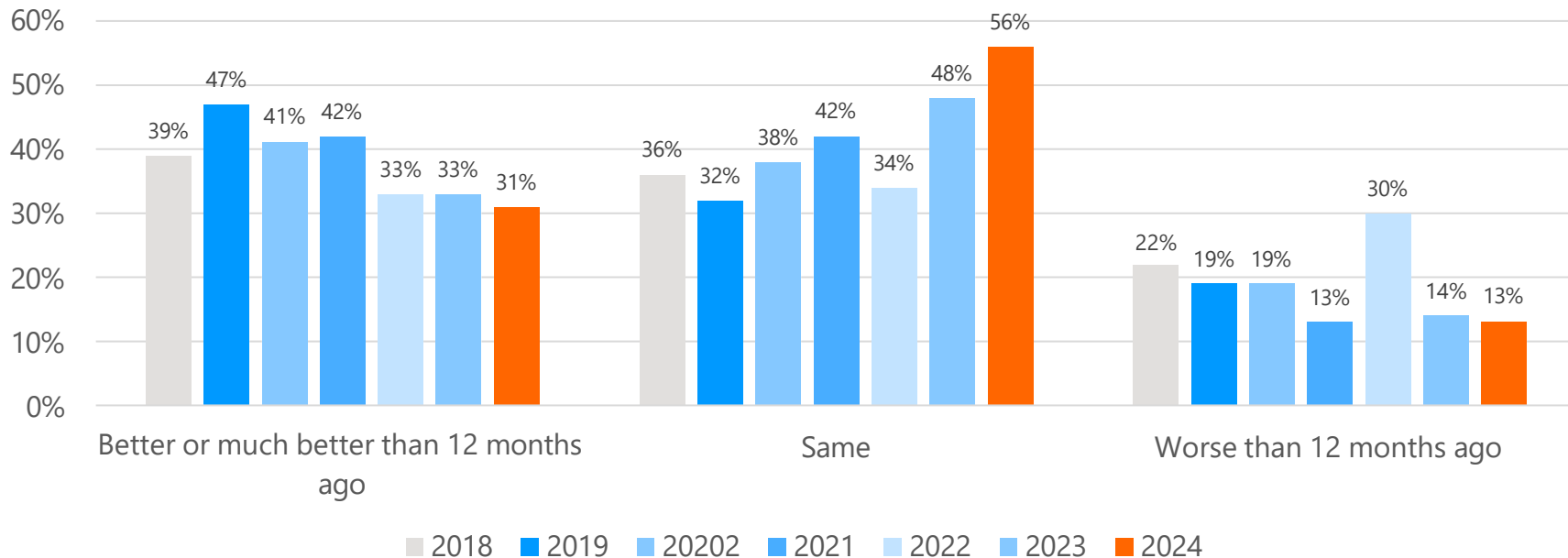

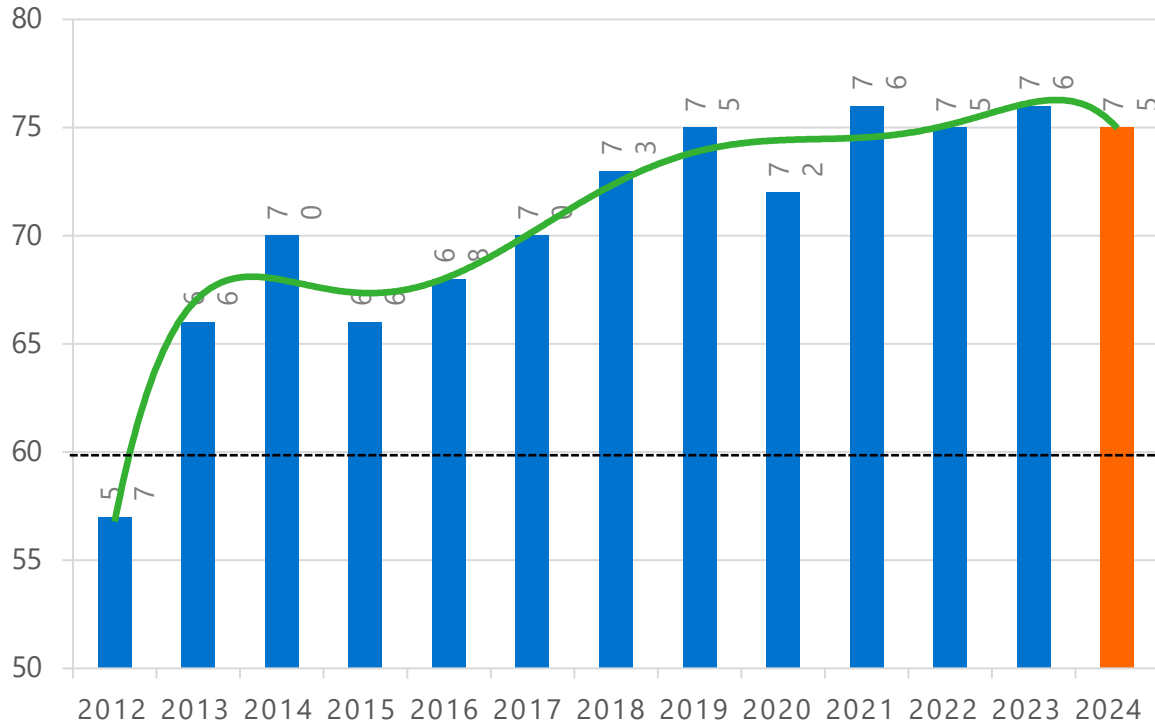

Our overall score has slightly decreased since the previous year.

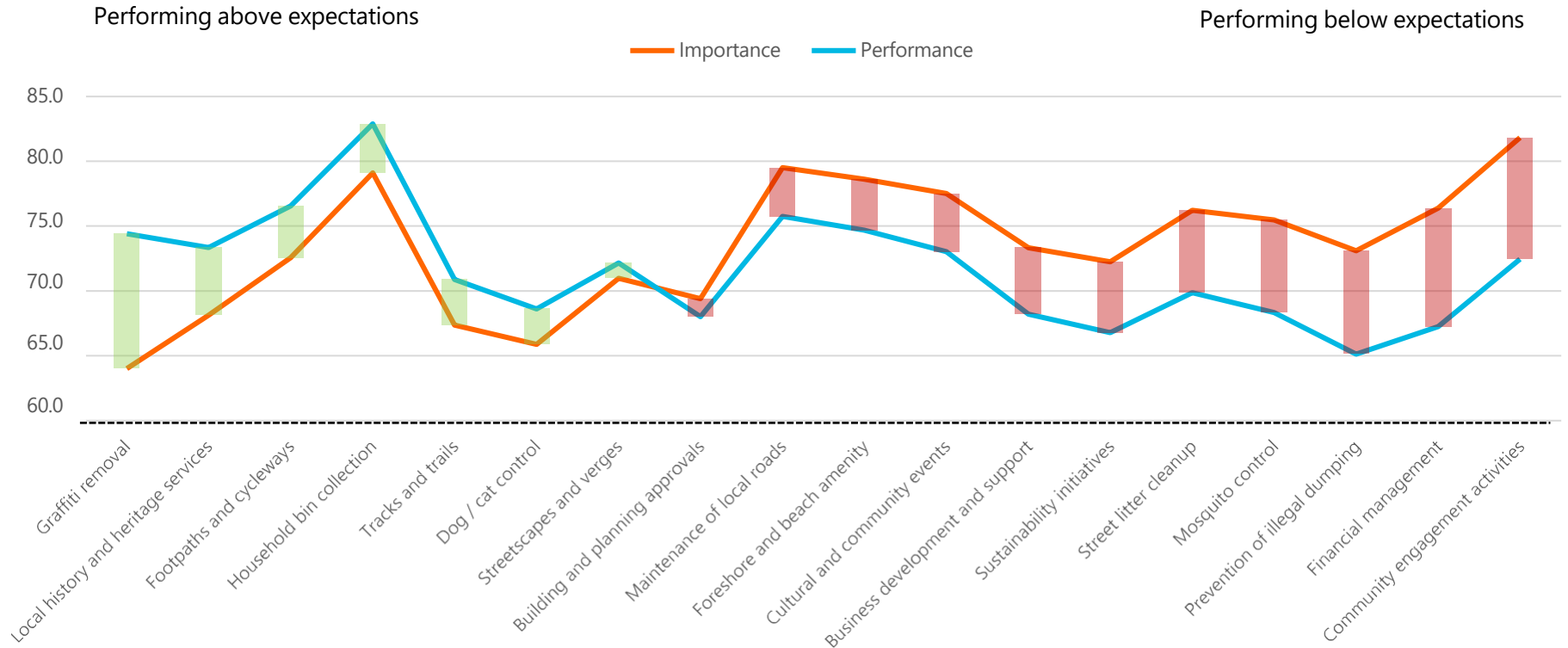

Gap change 2023 vs 2024

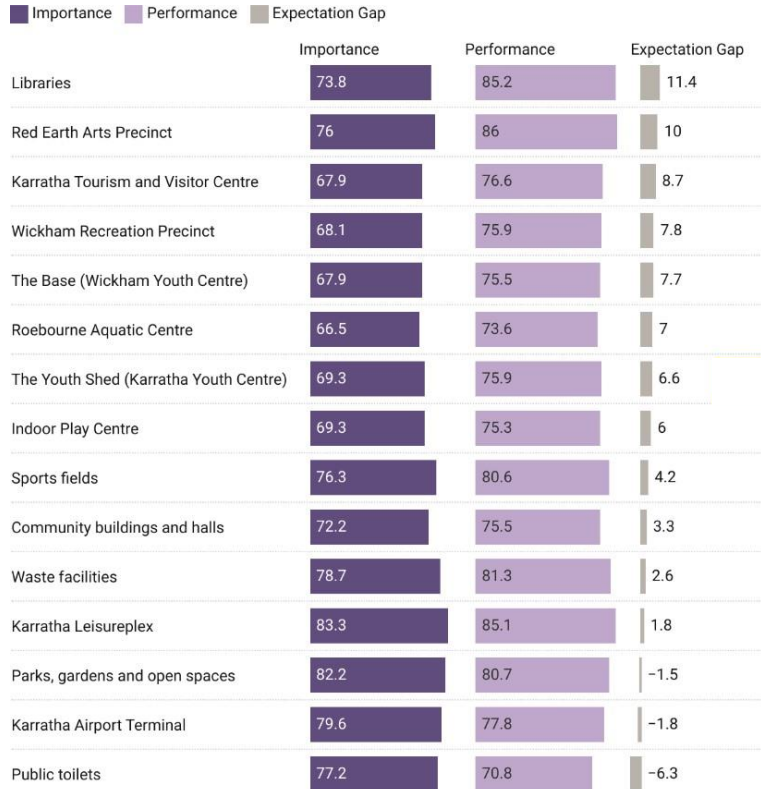
