# State Govt Election Commitment

- \$101,560 for Automatic Number Plate Recognition enabled CCTV cameras
- WA Police proposed five locations:
  - 3 in Karratha, 1 in Roebourne, 1 in Wickham
- City did not request funding
- City required to install, manage, maintain and replace cameras

# Preferred Sites identified by WA Police

1. De Witt Road, Stove Hill (near the intersection of Mooligunn Road)
2. Madigan Road, Gap Ridge (intersection of North West Coastal Highway)
3. Dampier Road, Gap Ridge (near Steel Avenue)
4. Cleaverville Road / North West Coastal Highway, Roebourne at the intersection of Point Samson-Roebourne Road
5. Mulga Way, Wickham (near intersection with Carse Street)

# Community Safety

- Benefits include: improved investigative capability, faster identification of vehicles linked to incidents, stronger evidence and general deterrence
- No intention to be used for: traffic laws such as mobile phones, speeding or seatbelts.

## **Recommendation:**

- Council support on a 5 year trial basis, no commitment to replacement
