

Rear Access Ways FAQs

Applications

I want to keep my existing rear access way. What do I need to do?

The first step is to book an inspection with a City Technical Engineering Officer. This needs to be completed between February 2020 and June 2020 (inclusive). There is no cost and you can book your inspection online at: <https://karratha.wa.gov.au/vehicle-crossover>.

Following the onsite feasibility inspection, the City's Technical Engineering Officer will either note your existing rear access way as compliant or provide advice on what upgrades are required to become compliant.

If upgrades are required, you will need to complete the *Application for Rear Access Construction or Upgrade Request form*.

This confirms your intent to upgrade and notifies the City's Technical Services Department of the inspections required during construction.

On completion of construction a final inspection must be carried out by a City Technical Engineering Officer to ensure compliance and approve of the rear access way against your property.

The Owner (property owner) of the asset assumes responsibility for all maintenance and repairs caused by any event that damages the storm water and rear access way infrastructure.

I want to build a new rear access way. What do I need to do?

The first step is to book an inspection with our Technical Engineering Officer. There is no cost and you can book your inspection online at: <https://karratha.wa.gov.au/vehicle-crossover>.

During the onsite visit, the City's Technical Engineering Officer will provide advice on what works are required to ensure your rear access is constructed compliantly.

Following the onsite feasibility inspection, if you choose to continue through to construction of a new rear access way, you then need to complete the *Application for Rear Access Construction or Upgrade Request form*.

This confirms your intent to upgrade and notifies the City's Technical Services Department of the inspections required during construction.

On completion of construction, a final inspection must be carried out by a City Technical Engineering Officer to ensure compliance and approve of the rear access way against your property.

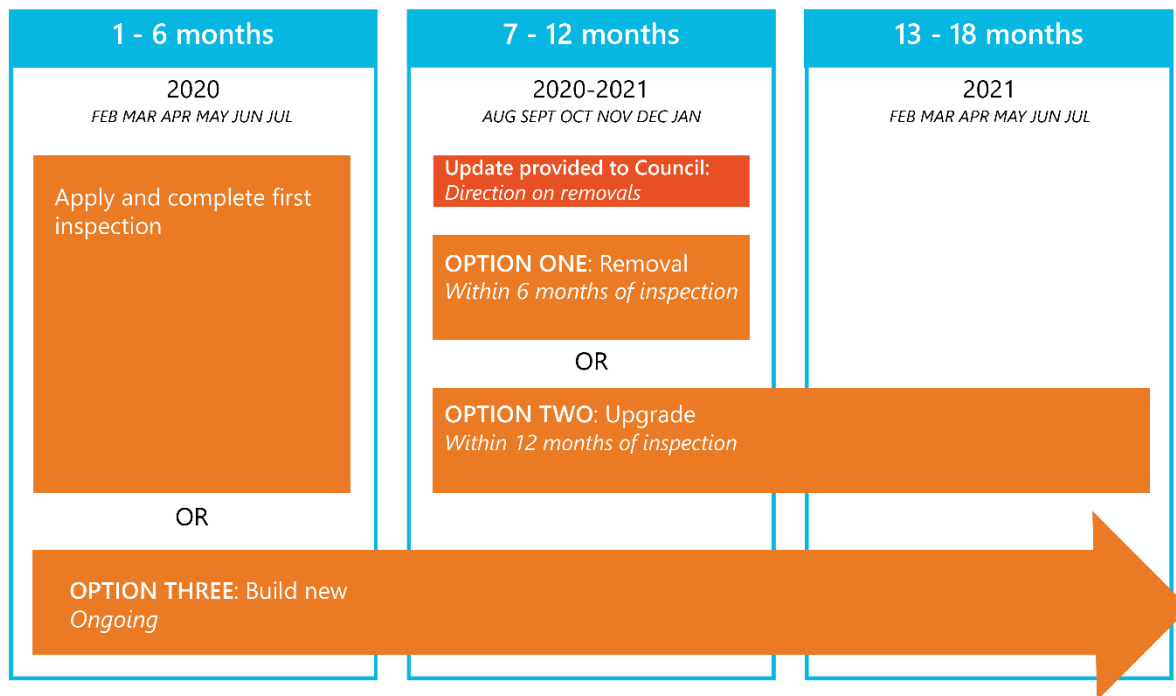
The Owner (property owner) of the asset assumes responsibility for all maintenance and repairs caused by any event that damages the storm water and rear access way infrastructure.
