ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAWS

The Council of the City of Karratha resolved on 18 March 2019 to adopt the following local law:

Dogs Local Law 2019

The purpose of the proposed Dogs Local Law 2019 is to provide for the additional controls and management of matters relating to dogs that are not specified in the Dog Act 1976 and provide clarity to promote and encourage responsible dog ownership. The effect of the Dogs Local Law 2019 is to provide regulatory measures in relation to impounding of dogs, the number of dogs that can be kept, establishment of approved kennels and the manner in which dogs are to be confined by the occupier of the premises and to promote and encourage responsible dog ownership whilst providing authority to enforce the laws and administer fines.

The local law was published in the Government Gazette on 29 April 2019, and will come into effect on 13 May 2019.
