Cat owner's responsibilities

- 1. The cats registration tag must be worn at all times when in a public place;
- 2. All cats aged over six months must be registered, microchipped and sterilised in accordance with the *Cat Act (2011)*. Penalties apply for not complying with the Act;
- 3. There is a limit of three (3) cats per household;
- 4. The City of Karratha must be advised immediately of any changes of details (i.e. deceased, ownership, address etc.);
- 5. Under the *Cat Act (2011)*, it is illegal to sell or give away kittens without an accompanying voucher for sterilisation.

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
