This collection is managed in accordance with the *Privacy and Responsible Information Sharing Act 2024 (WA)* and the City's Privacy Statement.

Your information may be disclosed to authorised City staff, contractors, consultants, relevant government agencies, emergency services, law enforcement, veterinarians, and authorised animal management agencies where required or authorised by law, or where necessary to assess your application, administer the registration, maintain accurate records, and carry out the City's statutory functions.

This information is collected in accordance with the *Cat Act 2011 (WA)*, the *Cat Regulations 2012 (WA)*, the *Local Government Act 1995 (WA)*, other relevant Western Australian legislation, and is subject to the *Freedom of Information Act 1992 (WA)*.

Cat owner's responsibilities

1. The cats registration tag must be worn at all times when in a public place;
2. All cats aged over six months must be registered, microchipped and sterilised in accordance with the Cat Act (2011). Penalties apply for not complying with the Act;
3. There is a limit of three (3) cats per household;
4. The City of Karratha must be advised immediately of any changes of details (i.e. deceased, ownership, address etc.);
5. Under the Cat Act (2011), it is illegal to sell or give away kittens without an accompanying voucher for sterilisation.
