WHAT IS AN ADVERTISEMENT?

Advertisement means any word, letter, model, sign, placard, board, notice, device, or representation, whether illuminated or not, in the nature of, and employed wholly or partly for the purposes of, advertisement, announcement or direction, and includes any hoarding or similar structure used, or adapted for use, for the display of advertisements.


Advertising signage within the City of Karratha is subject to the requirements and provisions of the following statutory documents:

- Local Planning Policy DP22 Advertising Signs
- Activities in thoroughfares and public places and trading local law 2017 (only when advertising signs are proposed on public land).

PLANNING APPROVAL

<u>Local Planning Policy DP22 - Advertising Signs</u> sets out development standards for advertising signs and is the key policy document that informs approvals requirements and the decision making process.

If your sign meets the development standards in LPP DP22, then development approval is not required. Development approval is only required if proposed signage does not meet the development standards in LPP DP22.



BUILDING APPROVAL

Due to the City's location in a cyclonic wind zone, many types of signs require a Building Permit, this includes sign types 4, 6, 7, 8, 11 & 12. Awning and wall signs (types 1 & 9) may also require a Building Permit depending on the proposed design and whether or not they project from the façade.

ADVERTISING IN A THOROUGHFARE

All advertisement signage in Road Reserves requires a Permit under the City's 'Activities in Thoroughfares & Public Places and Trading Local Law'. A permit can be obtained by submitting an application form. The relevant application form and lodgement checklist can be found here.
