GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS

Eligibility

To qualify for the Walking Award, you need to be:

- Studying Year 12 with four or more ATAR subjects
- Reside within the City of Karratha and be enrolled at a local high school or in equivalent education.

Submission Requirements:

Academic achievement

Include a copy of your Year 12 report card along with any supporting evidence of your academic achievements, such as certificates, awards or other relevant documentation.

School and community involvement

In no more than two pages, tell us about your involvement in your school and community. This may include leadership roles, participation in local community activities, volunteering, extracurricular involvement and other positive contributions.

References

Provide at least three reference letters from people who can verify your achievements and involvement. Please ensure each reference includes the referee's name, contact details and their relationship to you.

Supporting material (optional)

You may also include up to three additional supporting items, such as newspaper articles, social media posts or other material that highlights your achievements and contributions.

Proof of residency

Applicants must reside within the City of Karratha. Please provide your residential address as part of your application. Your school will be asked to verify your residency.
